

Itinerary for "Germany, Austria, Slovenia & Italy featuring the Passion Play in Oberammergau"

September 13 - 28, 2020

Sunday, September 13

Depart from Detroit Metro for our flight to Munich, Germany. Our departure this evening will take approximately 9 hours.

Monday, September 14

Arrival this morning into Munich. Our coach and driver will be waiting to take us to Oberndorf, Austria to visit the "Silent Night" Chapel. Then continue on to Salzburg where we will have an afternoon guided city tour. Overnight in the Salzburg area.

Tuesday, September 15

This morning we depart for Vienna making several stops enroute. This afternoon we will be visiting a chocolate factory, overnight in Vienna.

Wednesday, September 16

This morning there will be a city tour of Vienna with a combination of walking and utilizing our coach. This will include the Opera House, Ringstrasse, Jewish Quarter, Hofburg Palace from the outside & St. Stephan's Cathedral. A visit to the Schoenbrunn Palace has also been scheduled today. Overnight in Vienna.

Thursday, September 17

Today we travel to Styria, one of 9 Austrian states. The town of Piber will be a stop where we will visit the Lipizzaner Stallion stud farm. Overnight nearby.

Friday, September 18

Today's drive will take us to Lake Wörth where we will have some free time. Then continue on to Ljubljana in Slovenia. This afternoon we will enjoy a walking tour of the city. Accommodations nearby.

Saturday, September 19

This morning we are on our way to Venice where we will experience the Venetian way with a walking tour. We will be making a stop at St. Mark's Cathedral. Overnight in the area.

Sunday, September 20

Venice - Visit Burano which is known for its brightly colored fisherman

and also a stop at Murano, the glass blowing factory. Free time will be made available for those that wish to do a canal ride. Overnight in the Venice area.

Monday, September 21

Continue to Milan with a stop in Verona. Here we have a guided tour as well as the tasting of risotto. This afternoon we stop at Lake Garda for some free time and then continue on to Milan. Overnight in the area.

Tuesday, September 22

A guided walking tour of Milan this morning and then a visit to the beautiful Duomo cathedral which was started in 1386. A visit is also scheduled for "The Last Supper", a famous painting by Leonardo DaVinci, finished in 1407. Overnight in the area.

Wednesday, September 23

This morning we will again return to Austria and do a city tour of Bolzano. Then arrive into Innsbruck later in the day. Overnight in the area.

Thursday, September 24

Continue our journey to the Basilica Monastery in Ettal. We will have a tour here and learn how the monks make and sell their fine wines and liquors. We continue to Oberammergau later this morning. Passion Play tickets will be distributed to all those going to the play. You will be given a textbook on the play in English.

Friday, September 25

A stop is made this morning at the Linderhof Castle which is one of three castles built by King Ludwig. We will be stopping at the beautiful Wies church this afternoon.

Saturday, September 26

Today's visits include Mittenwald, Garmisch and the surrounding areas in the beautiful German Alps.

Sunday, September 27

City tour of Munich this morning; combination of walking and tour by coach. Perhaps lunch could be at the Hofbräuhaus. Your options this afternoon can be for last minute shopping or a visit to the Oktoberfest. Overnight the last 3 or 4 nights will be either in the Munich or Innsbruck region.

Monday, September 28

Our motorcoach takes us to the Munich Airport for our flight to Detroit with an arrival on the same day. Tour ends with a wealth of incredible memories.
